



Scholarship PwC Switzerland - EMBA USI Regulations 2021-2023

Value

One scholarship is worth CHF 26,000 (50% of the fee), of which PwC will contribute up to 8,000 CHF.

Eligibility and conditions of award

Eligible for the scholarship are executives with a significant experience with *Med Tech Life Sciences* markets, which are admitted to EMBA at USI, and make a specific request. Candidates are approved as specified here under by a Committee.

The Committee is made up of the current EMBA Director and the PwC Assurance Partner.

The Committee meets in April 2020 and communicates its decisions directly to the applicants.

The Committee's ruling is final and cannot be disputed.

The scholarship is paid by PwC in the form of a study subsidy, which is non-refundable.

Selection criteria

To be granted the scholarship candidates need to:

- have a significant experience in *Med Tech Life Sciences* markets
- have been admitted to EMBA10
- not being sponsored by a company, organization or institution to attend the EMBA
- make the application (CV and motivation letter) to emba@usi.ch until the end of March 2021.

PwC scholarship may not be drawn concurrently with other study grants or bursaries allocated by USI.
